"DOGE False Savings"

Topic - \$2 Trillion or \$150 Billion?

When Trump created DOGE (Department of Government Efficiency) and anointed Elon Musk as the person to be the head chainsaw, Musk promptly claimed that he would quickly shave \$2,000,000,000 (that's two Trillion) dollars from the government budget.

Several observations:

- "Efficiency" and "Savings" are not necessarily the same thing. Cutting jobs, cancelling contacts and stealing data from sensitive sources does not make a government more "efficient".
- Targeting \$2 Trillion in savings, reducing the goal to \$1 trillion and then to \$150 billion does not appear to reflect that planning had been careful and reasonable.
- Reporting savings realized to date on a website "The Wall" has proven to be less than transparent or accurate.

We are learning much about the poor planning, challenges from the courts, inaccurate reporting of savings, and truly heartless ignoring of the effect of the actions on the public. And recent reports indicate that the so-called cost savings may result in actually as much or more cost increases.
